As part of our efforts, the first event in favor of the air you breathe was held with the foreign community of La Paz. The event "Wine night for the air you breathe" took place at the facilities of our corporate partner Puerta Cortés. During the event there was a wine tasting, a screening of the documentary "Tiburones del Mar de Cortés, ¿un tesoro perdido?" and a silent auction of wines donated by Otto Hernandez president of the National Sommeliers Organization and Ricardo Uribe owner of Vinos para México (VIPARMEX).

This event will take place on April 2nd at 5:30 pm, the starting point will be the malecon of La Paz, in addition to the race there will be information booths on energy and air quality. #### **COPARMEX forums**

#### **Media Appearances**

Our executive director Jaqueline Valenzuela Meza gave interviews to diverse local and national media, including El Heraldo, BCS Noticias, Meganoticias, El Sudcaliforniano y Radio Fórmula; during these talks, environmental quality and mobility were discussed.

In addition to a note to talk about the incident the occurred on February 13 when a fire broke out in machine room number 5 on the Punta Prieta Thermoelectric plant, which resulted in an increase in pollution levels in the city of La Paz, as well as the importance of the air quality monitoring network to generate environmental alerts in situations of environmental contingencies.



#### **New Projects**

CERCA starting a new project in conjunction with COSCYT about the distribution of electricity to rural communities that don't have electricity supply. The energy department, headed by engineer Tanya Martinez together whit director Jaqueline Valenzuela present the proposal to COSCYT and agree on the next step to start the project.



#### **Events**

We participated in an event of the **Instituto Sudcaliforniano** de la **Juventud (ISJ)** with the purpose of pronouncing the voice of young people in the discussion of "youth before the discussion on national energy sovereignty" in the public agenda. As part of our goal of empowering citizens on environmental issues.

We also participated in the Wednesday Webinar on behalf of Comunicación Radio UABCS with the topics of "Electricity in your state-The case of Baja California Sur" where the engineer Tanya Martinez Ovando and the engineer Jesús Gastelum Bareño briefly explained how the electrical system is constituted in the state and where the energy is located by power plants; and the "Water availability in the municipality of La Paz, B.C.S., Mexico" which was given by Dr. Maria Z. Flores, who talked about groundwater and the current situation in Baja California Sur. This is one of the seminars we have given at CERCA with the purpose to keeping citizens informed.

# Health and Environmental Quality

#### **Air Quality Monitoring System**

During the month of February we made maintenance of the monitors that we have located in various schools that are located in strategic points of the city, also the monitor at Morelos High School was changed to ensure thet the data obtained are reliable and to indicate to the public the status of air quality through our monitoring network that can be consulted at <a href="https://www.airelimpiobcs.org.mx">www.airelimpiobcs.org.mx</a>







Also, the second CERCA A. C. weather station was installed in the city of La Paz. This station is located in the new CERCA installations; whit this station it is possible to measure precipitation, humidity, temperature, wind direction and speed. Knowing this information allow us to determine how the pollutants found in the air you breathe behave.







#### **New monitors**

We contacted new schools that are located in strategic points to invite them to be part of our monitoring network. Now CBTIS 230 and Julieta Castro Hieras elementary school are part of this great project; we also made an agreement with a citizen who lives in the Zacatal neighborhood to install a monitor in his house next to the weather station that issues weather alerts. With these new monitors we now have most of the city covered.

#### **Agreements**

We had a meeting with MarVivo to collaborate with them to carry out projects in the community of San Carlos, some of the topics discussed included the expansion of our monitoring network to these communities and a new project for the early detection of hydrocarbons in the water.





#### **Environmental education**

During 2022, we will be working on the development of an environmental education program, which will be aimed primarily at the educational sector, which aims to promote CERCA's work, education in terms of environmental issues in Sudcalifornia and ecological culture.
