
WHAT DO WE DO?



> The installed capacity in the Baja California Sur electrical system grew 49%, this is a historic increase, which also includes progress in renewable energy by including the operation of 3 renewable energy plants in the municipalities of La Paz and Comondu.

With the updated diagnosis of the installed capacity of the electrical system, CERCA has promptly informed the population of its progress, with more than 50 participations in local and national media and with a total of 204 media publications on issues related to the energy transition, achieving a reach of 300,675 people.



For the first time we reached communities isolated from the regional electricity grid; identifying in them an opportunity to be the first sustainable communities in BCS, which will be an example to follow for the sustainability of energy and environmental resources and the first to be truly prepared for the challenges that the climate crisis presents us.

Despite the pandemic conditions, our team remained active with online activities. Later we fortunately were able to return to schools and outdoor events, we participated in fishing waste tournaments, for the first time we made a direct alliance with the foreign community and we reached the rural communities of BCS. With the "Accercate al Paraiso" campaign, we achieved 2,400 reactions on social networks, 82 comments, 43,180 shares, 28,500 people reached on Instagram and more than 2,000 people who attended our activities in person.

Expansion of the monitoring network to the municipality of Los Cabos. Installation of air quality sensors in places frequented by cars.

A collaboration was carried out with three researchers from UNAM and IPN, in which studies and measurements were carried out on the emissions of atmospheric pollutants by power generation plants, through remote sensing equipment.



Thanks to the CERCA Technological Development technical team, the Air Quality Monitoring Network was expanded to the municipality of Los Cabos. In the same way, by understanding the various impacts of electricity generation plants, we expanded our study categories, now the monitoring areas include soil, water and waste. With this information, we will be able to better understand the need to urgently move away from the use of fossil fuels in all anthropogenic processes. Similarly, thanks to the support of our external collaborators, we were able to use innovative devices such as thermal cameras and devices for the analysis of marine sediment samples. Lastly, we closed the year with the successful collaboration for the acquisition of air quality regulatory booths by the BCS state government.



In the fire at the La Paz landfill on February 13, CERCA was the only entity that alerted the public and informed about the main risks associated with the health of the population.

Thanks to that, the CRIT suspended work so as not to expose the girls and boys who attend that Rehabilitation Center.
